




City of Asheville FY 2015 Carbon Footprint Update

Greenhouse Gas Emissions from Municipal Operations



Observations

- FY 2015 saw a 287 ton reduction in CO2 equivalent, or a 1.4% reduction from baseline. This did not achieve the annual 4% reduction goal, but City is still performing better than the target.
- FY 2015 reductions resulted from the following factors:
 - Increased shift to CNG in sanitation trucks
 - Overall more efficient fleet from accelerated vehicle replacement in recent years
 - Additional street light replacements
 - Decreased facility electric usage (City Hall HVAC controls project, several lighting projects)
- Reductions offset by higher impact from employee commute (over 5M VMT annually) and increased natural gas usage from colder winter
