SUBJECT: APD Call Analysis

The following chart demonstrates the call for service volume for the Asheville Police Department. The data period represented is the 2012 calendar year. The data was collected from the OSSI / Records Management System and Computer-Aided-Dispatch records.

The call for service analysis depicts a relatively consistent rate of calls for service by day, with Sunday being the lowest volume day of the week. Calls for service remain relatively consistent during the day or night, except Friday, Saturday and Sunday having a higher rate of calls for service in the evening and late night hours than during the day.
