



Follow-up to Feb. 6 public meeting

The City of Asheville Transportation Department held a public meeting on February 6, 2012 at the Jewish Community Center to gather community input on ways to make the Charlotte Street corridor safer for pedestrians.

Approximately 200 residents and property/business owners attended the meeting. Transportation Department Director Ken Putnam presented information on past [studies](#) and [plans](#) for the corridor and current traffic counts. He also presented information on possible strategies to address community concerns about pedestrian safety. Questions and comments were taken and will be used by city staff to determine next steps.
