What's happening now?

- The Transportation Department has finalized a design
- Residents on the street have collected the necessary 60% signatures in support of the project.
- The installation contract for 4 speed humps has been approved and notice to proceed with project issued.
- The project is projected to start on July 23 and be completed on July 31.
