What's happening now?

Clearing and rough grading has been completed along the stream bed in preparation for installation of hardscape including walls and boulders to stabilize the stream margins, which will begin this winter. Installation of plant materials will be completed in the fall of 2015.

The last phase of this component of the project will be the grading and installation of plantings to implement Stormwater Best Management Practices (BMPs) for the project which will be completed in the fall of 2015.

Background

In addition to the stormwater best management practices that will be designed and installed as a part of the transportation-related projects, the City will design and install a comprehensive restoration and improvement of the unnamed creek that starts above Waynesville Avenue and drains into the French Broad River through the New Belgium site.
