The City of Asheville is planning to improve Livingston Street and a portion of Depot Street with an approach called Complete Streets. The goal of the project is to make the street safer and more comfortable for all users, including pedestrians, bicyclists and transit users.

Timeline

Identified the project in East of the Riverway Connections transportation network planning process

Initial public meeting to gather input

Public input on preliminary design accepted via email

2015 NOVEMBER

Stakeholder meetings to review 25% plans

2016 FEBRUARY 16

Public meeting to review 75% plans

2016 MARCH

Consultant designs completed

Construction is anticipated to begin

What's happening now?

The final public meeting was held on February 16, 2016. The City anticipates construction beginning in 2017, and will provide notice to area residents and users prior to the start of construction.

Why it's happening

In March 2014, the City and community worked together on the East of the Riverway Connections transportation network plan, which identified capital improvement opportunities in the East of the Riverway area. That planning recommended improvements to Livingston Street that would make it a complete street.

East of the Riverway planning was funded with a Federal Highway Administration TIGER grant (Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery). TIGER grants fund planning for and construction of capital investments in surface transportation infrastructure.
