Why it's happening

The Linwood Crump Shiloh Center Complex is located at 121 Shiloh Road, Asheville NC, 28803. Originally an elementary school, the City of Asheville acquired it in 1970s and converted it to a public park and recreation center. The existing facilities are dated and in need of upgrading as the community and public interest in recreation facilities develop.

The recreation center is a two-story, 21,200 square foot building including a gymnasium, multipurpose room, library, classrooms, weight room, kitchen, storage, office, restrooms, outdoor patio, and parking.

The six-acre park consist of a playground, tennis court, ball field, basketball court, restrooms, walking trail, and parking.
