Definition

The mission of the Advocacy committee is to publically advocate for pre-approved projects by the City of Asheville & PACC to Asheville groups including city council members, Asheville City Council, other boards pertinent to endorsement of proposed project.

I. Composition of subcommittee: (4-5 members)

II. Terms of Office:

Terms of office are for two years with the option to re-up at the end of service term with a maximum of two two-year terms, including the Chair.

III. Selection of Officers:

Recommendations will be taken for any person on the current PACC board and local members of the Asheville arts community.

IV. Staff Support:

This subcommittee will need staff support for drafting proposals in a language appropriate for proposal.

V. Purposes, Responsibilities, and Powers:

- 1) This committee will take direct recommendations for advocacy voted upon by the PACC.
- 2) This committee is tasked with promoting and recommending proposals;
- 3) Defining best approaches and presentations of proposals and who their listening audience is for PACC-approved proposals.
- 4) This committee (or a representative of this committee) could be responsible for meeting one-on-one with community leaders, boards and groups and or speaking in a public forum on behalf of the PACC.
- 5) Attendance will require 75% of meetings scheduled three times per year and on as needed basis.
- 6) Additional meetings will be scheduled on an “as needed” basis.
