## **Purpose and Responsibilities of Subcommittee**

The Partnerships Subcommittee is to play an active role in helping form or guide non-contractual partnerships between the City of Asheville and individual artists and/or arts organizations. Commission and other sub-committees may submit recommendations that the Partnerships Committee will prioritize.

### **I. Composition of Subcommittee:**

Members will total 5, including Chair. Members (TBD) will be knowledgeable with Asheville area arts organizations and artists. Members who have a stake in a potential or actual on-going partnership with the City of Asheville must recuse themselves in the event of a vote event.

### **II. Terms of Office:**

Terms of office are for two years with the option to re-up at the end of service term, with a maximum of two 2-year terms, including Chair.

### **III. Meeting Times and Frequency:**

Quarterly meetings will be held at best time to be determined (TBD) by subcommittee members. If a subcommittee member misses more than one meeting annually, they may be removed from the subcommittee by the commission. Additional meetings will be scheduled on an as-needed basis; attendance at these additional meetings is expected.

### **IV. Guidelines:**

The Partnerships Subcommittee serves in an advisory capacity to the Public Art and Cultural Commission. This subcommittee will take direct recommendations for partnerships between the City of Asheville and individual artists and/or arts organizations, as voted upon by the PACC. The Committee will help determine the feasibility of said partnerships and make suggestions and recommendations back to the Commission and Staff as needed. The Partnership Committee will make regular reports and recommendations to the Public Art and Cultural Commission, and will assist Staff as needed.
