


RECOMMENDATION MAP




WHERE & HOW CAN THE CITY INCREASE LEVEL OF SERVICE?

- CITY WIDE**
- Maintain a high level of maintenance throughout park system to ensure a continued level of service.
 - Enrich existing parks with theming and implement design standards that reflect the character of the city and/or the neighborhood.

- ★ Create connections between parks to increase level of service. (Examples: signage, maps, loop walks, unpaved trails, greenway, public art)
 - #1 White Fawn Park/Memorial Stadium/McCormick Field/Mountainside Park
 - #2 Meadow Park/Seven Springs Park/Kenilworth Park
 - #3 Sunset Park/Grove Park
- ★ Increase diversity of components in parks.
 - #4 Add a spray feature/destination playground to Recreation Park.
- ★ Develop/improve into regional parks.
 - #5 White Fawn Park/Memorial Stadium/McCormick Field/Mountainside Park
 - #6 Recreation Park/Azalea Park/WNC Nature Center

- Continue to plan for land acquisition.
 - High Priority - Create and strengthen the urban network of downtown parks and connection to greenways
- Focus on developing/improving existing parks and greenways to maintain or increase level of service.
 - Maintain existing amenities and add additional components and comfort and convenience features
