### Swamp Rabbit Bike Trail

Dec. 17, and April 5

We'll head south to just outside of Greenville, SC where we will catch the Swamp Rabbit Greenway. We'll bike about 10 miles along the beautiful trail to Falls Park and then return on the same path. (20 miles total ride) Although the trip is mostly flat, riders must be very comfortable on bikes. Riders may bring their own bike/helmet that is in good condition. Participants may bring their lunch in a backpack on the ride - or stop at a cafe and purchase lunch. Depart the Recreation Office at 9:30 am; return about 5:00 pm. Fee: \$18 R; \$20 NR. Minimum 6 participants. Bike Rentals area available for a \$30 fee, they must be reserved in advance.


