**Asheville Police and Buncombe County Sheriff's Office Conducting Joint Investigation  
Regarding Missing Persons**

**Asheville, NC (October 29, 2015):** The Buncombe County Sheriff's Office and the Asheville Police Department are conducting a joint investigation regarding missing persons, Alexandra Brooke King and Tatianna Dis, who were last seen on October 27<sup>th</sup> leaving Canterbury Place Apartments in between the hours of 9:00 and 10:00 p.m. The number one priority for both agencies at this time is locating Alexandra and Tatianna.

The dark blue VW Jetta belonging to Alexandra King was recovered yesterday morning on Craven Street at the edge of the French Broad River near the New Belgium Brewery site. We are investigating the connection between these missing persons and Pierre Lamont Griffin II. Both women are considered to be endangered.

A multi-agency search, involving the Asheville Police Department, Buncombe County Sheriff's Office and State Highway Patrol, began yesterday and will continue throughout the day today.

A press conference will be held today, October 28<sup>th</sup>, at 11:30 a.m. outside of the Asheville Police Department. Representatives from both agencies will be present.
