

# Differences in the West of the City



These maps shows the West of Asheville in the **Existing Network** and the **Draft Network**. Remember that the Draft Network has been designed to focus a little more on services that can maximize ridership while keeping coverage in areas with many low-income persons.

## Removal of Coverage

In the West, the Draft Network removes service from these places:

- Tanger Outlets
- Outer Haywood Road (between Brevard and Patton)

## Higher Frequency

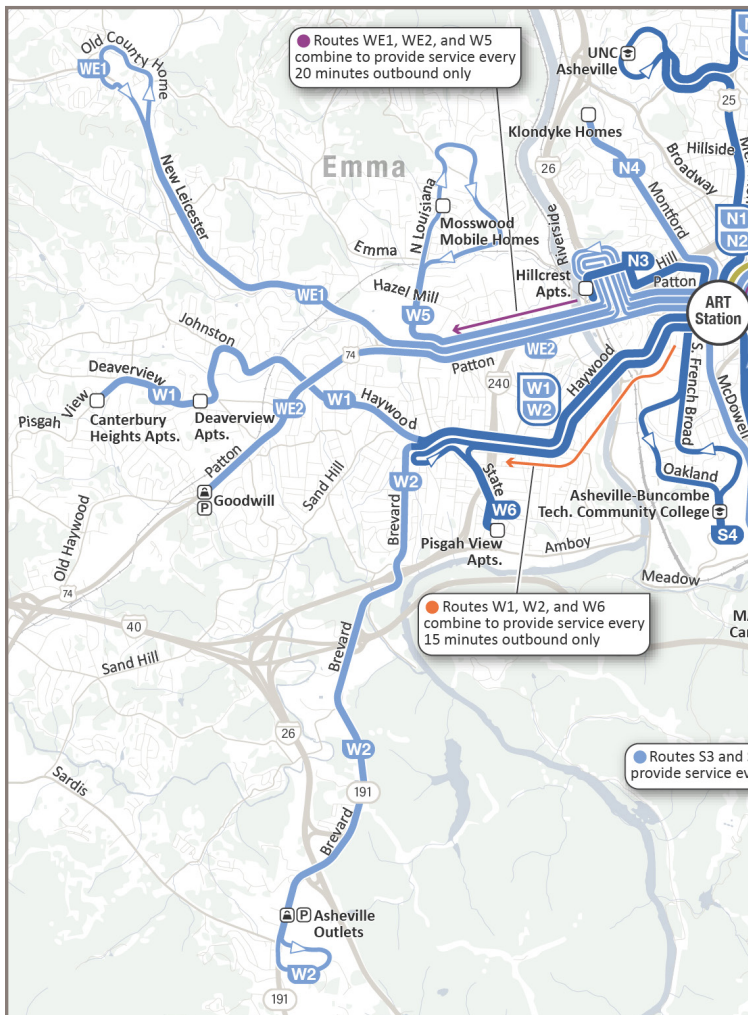
In the West, the Draft Network has

- 15-minute service from Downtown to the River Arts District
- 30-minute service west of Downtown along Patton Avenue

## Other changes

The routing in Deaverview is different. Instead of using Haywood, Deaverview is now connected to Downtown via Patton Avenue. Since Patton is a faster street, this will improve travel time and on-time performance.
